ORDERED:

Walter Marland Hackett, Jr. is suspended from the practice of law for ten days, with reinstatement conditioned on payment of the outstanding costs and expenses owing in the two 2005 disciplinary matters, including interest. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Walter Marland Hackett, Jr. As of July 2014 the total amount is \$2,184.20.
