- 2. You recorded a lien against the client's real property. *Ross v. Scannell*, 97 Wn.2d 598, 647 P.2d 1004 (1982) prohibits filing a lien against real property unless the unpaid fees have been reduced to judgment. You did not obtain a judgment.
