ORDER APPROVING
STIPULATION TO DISBARMENT

This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving Stipulation to Disbarment pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Stephen Tadashi Araki, his counsel, and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on October 10, 2013. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Stephen Tadashi Araki is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Stephen Tadashi Araki.
