This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving a Stipulation to Nine-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Brian K. Hammer, his counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on February 1, 2016. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the stipulation to suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Brian K. Hammer is suspended from the practice of law for nine months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Brian K. Hammer shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment of restitution to Aimee Sorensen in the amount of \$9,150.40 and payment to the Washington State Bar Association of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$695 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i).
