This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to One-Year Suspension. The stipulation was signed by David E. LaDow, his counsel, and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on November 6, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing a one-year suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

David E. LaDow is suspended from the practice of law for one year. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. LaDow shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
