REPRIMAND

Under the Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct promulgated by the Supreme Court of the State of Washington, you have been directed to receive this FORMAL REPRIMAND.

Between September 26, 2011 and March 22, 2012, on seven separate occasions, you failed to appear in Immigration Court for scheduled court appearances for your clients, causing inconvenience to the court, your clients, and the government.

In addition, in 2011-2012, you represented Delfino Velazquez-Camacho in immigration proceedings. In April 2012, Mr. Velazquez-Camacho contacted a new lawyer. Despite repeated requests from Mr. Velazquez-Camacho's wife, you did not provide Mr. Velazquez-Camacho or the new lawyer with a copy of the client file. You failed to protect Mr. Velazquez-Camacho's interests prior to and upon your withdrawal, causing injury and potential injury to

1 Mr. Velazquez-Camacho.

2 Your conduct in failing to appear for scheduled court appearances violated RPC 8.4(d)  
3 and RPC 1.3.

4 Your conduct in failing to take steps to protect Mr. Velazquez-Camacho's interests prior  
5 to and upon your withdrawal violated RPC 1.3 and RPC 1.16(d).


6 These actions merit a Formal Reprimand. Your actions discredit you and the legal  
7 profession and show a disregard for the high traditions of honor expected from a member of the  
8 Association.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY REPRIMANDED by the Washington State  
10 Bar Association for this misconduct. This Reprimand will be made a part of your permanent  
11 record with the Association, and will be considered along with other evidence regarding any  
12 future grievances against you.

13 Your privilege to practice law in the State of Washington is based on the finding that  
14 you are a person of good moral character, and on your commitment to abide by the rules  
15 governing the conduct of members of the Association. The Association expects all your future  
16 conduct as a lawyer to be consistent with that finding as to your character, and with a continuing  
17 commitment on your part to the letter and spirit of those rules.
