This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving a Stipulation to a Three Year Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Charles William Rehm, his counsel, and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on May 21, 2014. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the stipulation to suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Charles William Rehm is suspended from the practice of law for three years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Charles William Rehm.
