This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 18-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Dean Browning Webb and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on May 5, 2017. On August 8, 2017, Mr. Webb filed a letter requesting that the date of the suspension be stayed until after oral argument in a federal case. On August 9, 2017, WSBA counsel filed a letter opposing the stay. After review of the Board's order, the stipulation and the file, the Court determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to 18-Month Suspension and denying the stay should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Dean Browning Webb is suspended from the practice of law for 18 months. Mr. Webb's request for stay of the effective date of suspension is denied. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Webb shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
