By decision and order of the Court of Appeals of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation filed April 21, 2016, Scot D. Stuart was publicly censured. Mr. Stuart, who at the time was Chief Judge of the Colville Tribal Court, was disciplined because he violated Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation Rules of Judicial Conduct (RJC) § 1.3.01 (honesty and integrity) and RJC § 1.4.01(c) (diligence and impartiality). ELC 9.2(f) provides that a final adjudication in another jurisdiction of lawyer misconduct conclusively establishes the misconduct for purposes of a disciplinary proceeding in this state. Upon notification of the action of the Court of Appeals of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation, this Court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mr. Stuart to inform this Court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. Mr. Stuart did not file a response. The Court has reviewed the file in this matter and has unanimously determined that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and orders that Scot D. Stuart be reprimanded. The reprimand is deemed administered on this date.
