This matter came before the Supreme Court on the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Chris Alan Montgomery, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation of suspension. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order, the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation, the Respondent's Motion to Amend, Modify & Correct Hearing Officer's Decision - ELC 10.16(c), and the Order on Respondent's Motion to Amend, Modify & Correct Hearing Officer's Decision - ELC 10.16(c) and the Court determined unanimously that this order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

Chris Alan Montgomery is suspended from the practice of law for six months. His reinstatement is conditioned upon (1) the successful completion of 6.00 CLE credits in the area of ethics specifically dealing with conflict of interest, and (2) payment of any costs and expenses assessed in the disciplinary proceeding. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order.
