ORDER APPROVING
STIPULATION
TO NINE-MONTH SUSPENSION

This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Nine-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Christopher William Bawn and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on January 28, 2016. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the stipulation to suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Christopher William Bawn is suspended from the practice of law for nine months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Christopher William Bawn shall comply with all terms of the stipulation including the payment of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$750 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i) and restitution, as required by Section VII of the stipulation.
