This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board’s Order Approving Stipulation to 60-Day Suspension. The stipulation was signed by William Clay Budigan, his counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on June 4, 2018. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing a 60-day suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

William Clay Budigan is suspended from the practice of law for 60 days. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Budigan shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
