This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 30-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Charles Wade Peach and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on February 7, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined, by a majority, that an order approving the Stipulation to 30-Month Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Charles Wade Peach is suspended from the practice of law for 30 months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Mr. Peach shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$1,000 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i).
