This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 60-Day Suspension. The stipulation was signed by Theodore Robert Parry, his counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on May 18, 2018. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing a 60-day suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Theodore Robert Parry is suspended from the practice of law for 60 days. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Mr. Parry shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
