This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving a Stipulation to a Three-Year Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Brian Jeffrey Carl and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on March 9, 2015. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to a Three-Year Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

In accordance with ELC 13.9(i), Brian Jeffrey Carl shall pay attorneys fees and administrative costs of \$750 to the Washington State Bar Association.
