This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Jerome Chilwell Scowcroft, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation of suspension. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and determined unanimously that this order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

**ORDERED:**

Jerome Chilwell Scowcroft is suspended from the practice of law for one year followed by probation for a period of two years beginning on the date Mr. Scowcroft is reinstated to active status to practice law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Scowcroft shall comply with the conditions of probation specified in the Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officers Recommendation.
