ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING
STIPULATION (ELC 9.1(d))

ACTION REQUIRED

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its December 13, 2019 meeting.

On review of the October 31, 2019 Stipulation to Three-Month Suspension, the Board finds that the stipulation, as submitted, would result in a manifest injustice given the pattern of misconduct.

IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation is approved¹ on the parties' agreement to add the following condition:

The length of the suspension will be changed from 3 months to 6 months.


This stipulation, as conditioned, will be deemed approved if both parties serve written consent to the conditional term. The written consent must be served on the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order.

The Board will reconsider this decision if the parties file a joint motion requesting reconsideration. This motion should be in writing and filed with the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order. The parties may ask to address the Board.
