ORDER APPROVING

STIPULATION TO SIX-MONTH
SUSPENSION

This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Six-Month Suspension and Granting Protective Order pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Michele Avalon Michalek, her counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on August 22, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to Six-Month Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Michele Avalon Michalek is suspended from the practice of law for six months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is retroactive to June 20, 2017. Michele Avalon Michalek shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
