This matter came before the Court (Justice Montoya-Lewis did not participate; Justice Fairhurst participated as justice pro tem) to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Four Month Suspension. The stipulation indicates that Mr. Booth requests that the suspension be effective April 1, 2020, and the Office of Disciplinary Counsel does not oppose that request. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined by majority that an order imposing a four-month suspension should be entered.
