ORDER
PURSUANT TO
ELC 9.2

On May 14, 2015, the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon entered an opinion disbaring David Merrill Herman from the practice of law in the State of Oregon. ELC 9.2(e) provides that a final adjudication of lawyer misconduct in another jurisdiction conclusively establishes the misconduct for purposes of a disciplinary proceeding in this state. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, this Court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing David Merrill Herman to inform this Court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. David Merrill Herman did not file a response. The Court has reviewed the file in this matter and has determined unanimously that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and orders that David Merrill Herman is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order.
