ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING STIPULATION (ELC 9.1(e))

ACTION REQUIRED

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its March 1, 2024, meeting.

On review of the February 6, 2024, Stipulation to Suspension,

IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation is approved¹ on the parties' agreement to add the following condition:

The stipulated restitution shall include interest at the legal rate of 12% from January 15, 2021, through the date the stipulation is approved.

This stipulation, as conditioned, will be deemed approved if both parties serve written consent to the conditional term. The written consent must be served on the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order.

The Board will reconsider this decision if the parties file a joint motion requesting reconsideration. This motion should be in writing and filed with the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order. The parties may ask to address the Board.

If either party fails to respond to this order in writing within 14 days, the Board
