ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING STIPULATION (ELC 9.1(d))

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its July 12, 2013 meeting.

On review of the Stipulation to Suspension, the Board approves the stipulation on the condition that the parties agree to increase the length of the suspension to 24 months. Respondent's conduct was knowing and the harm to some clients was serious. Additionally, the conduct in this matter is similar to *In re Shepard*, 169 Wn.2d 697, 239 P.3d 1066 92010). The Board recognizes that this is a stipulated result, but believes that the appropriate sanction should be consistent with *Shepard*. Allowing clients to believe they are represented by a lawyer, when the work is performed by a nonlawyer is a serious violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation is conditionally approved.<sup>1</sup> The stipulation, as conditioned, will be deemed approved, if, within 14 days of service of this order, both parties serve on the Clerk, written consent to the increased sanction noted in this order.

The parties may, within 14 days of service of this order, serve on the Clerk, a joint
