HEARING OFFICER'S DECISION


This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its November 1, 2013 meeting, on automatic review of Hearing Officer Jane Bremner Risley's Findings Of Fact, Conclusions Of Law And Hearing Officer's Recommendation, recommending a 2-year suspension, to be followed by probation, following a default hearing.
