This matter came before the Supreme Court on its December 12, 2013, En Banc Conference. The Court considered the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Marion Ellen Morgenstern, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation for a two year suspension, to be followed by probation. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and the Court determined by a majority that the order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby ORDERED:

Marion Ellen Morgenstern is suspended from the practice of law for two years followed by probation. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Marion Ellen Morgenstern.
