This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Suspension. The stipulation was signed by Sandra Wilton, her counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on October 9, 2018. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing a six-month suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Sandra Wilton is suspended from the practice of law for six months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Ms. Wilton shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
