This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 30-day Suspension. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing a 30-day suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Dallas William Jolley Jr. is suspended from the practice of law for 30 days. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Mr. Jolley shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
