This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving a Stipulation to Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Tamara M. Chin, her counsel, and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on February 4, 2014. **ORDERED:**

Tamara M. Chin is suspended from the practice of law for forty-five days and shall serve on probation for a period of one year. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Tamara M. Chin.
