On December 9, 2013, the Idaho State Supreme Court suspended Darren Lance McKenzie from the practice of law for five-years with 19 months withheld. ELC 9.2(e) provides that a final adjudication of lawyer misconduct in another jurisdiction conclusively establishes the misconduct for purposes of a disciplinary proceeding in this state. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Idaho, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Darren Lance McKenzie to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. Darren Lance McKenzie did not file a response. The court having reviewed the file in this matter has determined unanimously that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

## ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and orders that Darren Lance McKenzie is suspended from the practice of law for five years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2 the effective date of suspension is 7 days from date of this order.
