Under the Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct promulgated by the Supreme Court of the State of Washington, you have been directed to receive this FORMAL REPRIMAND.

In February 2010, you agreed to draft a complaint for a client who wished to bring a claim against her former employer. You drafted the complaint, but did not send a copy of the draft to your client to review and did not finalize or file the complaint.

Over the next several months, you were called out of town on a number of occasions due to the illness of a family member. Your client called and made several follow-up inquiries about the status of her matter, but did not receive a response from you, nor was she advised that you had been called away and were not available to pursue the matter for her.

Your conduct in failing to review the draft complaint with your client, finalize the

1	complaint, and file the complaint violated RPC 1.3.
2	You conduct in failing to respond to your client's inquiries about the status of her matter
3	and by failing to advise her that you were not available to complete her matter violated RCP 1.4.
4	These actions merit a Formal Reprimand. Your actions discredit you and the legal
5	profession and show a disregard for the high traditions of honor expected from a member of the
6	Association.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY REPRIMANDED by the Washington State
8	Bar Association for this misconduct. This Reprimand will be made a part of your permanent
9	record with the Association, and will be considered along with other evidence regarding any
10	future grievances against you.
11	Your privilege to practice law in the State of Washington is based on the finding that
12	you are a person of good moral character, and on your commitment to abide by the rules
13	governing the conduct of members of the Association. The Association expects all your future
14	conduct as a lawyer to be consistent with that finding as to your character, and with a continuing
15	commitment on your part to the letter and spirit of those rules.
