AMENDED ORDER CONDITIONALLY  
APPROVING STIPULATION (ELC 9.1(d))

**ACTION REQUIRED**

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its May 3, 2019 meeting.

On review of the April 12, 2019 Stipulation to 24-Month Suspension, the Board finds that the stipulation, as submitted, would result in a manifest injustice given the pattern of misconduct.

IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation is approved<sup>1</sup> on the parties' agreement to add the following condition:

The length of the suspension shall be 36-Months and include a subsequent 2-Year probation and practice monitoring upon reinstatement.

This stipulation, as conditioned, will be deemed approved if both parties serve written consent to the conditional term. The written consent must be served on the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order.

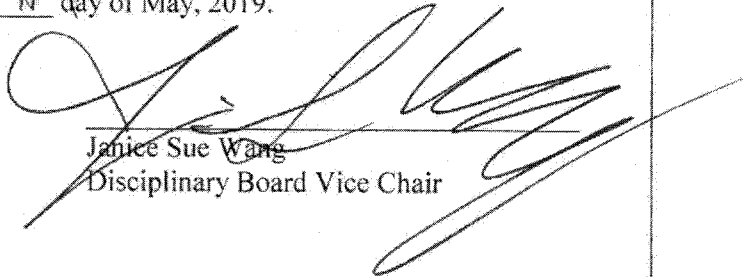
The Board will reconsider this decision if the parties file a joint motion requesting reconsideration. This motion should be in writing and filed with the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order. The parties may ask to address the Board.

<sup>1</sup> The vote was 6-2. Those voting for conditional approval of the stipulation per the terms above were: Wang, Vovos, Rawlings, Louvier, Gates, and Value. Doyle and Halwe voted to reject the stipulation. Hurl recused.

If either party fails to respond to this order in writing within 14 days, the Board will enter a final order rejecting the stipulation.

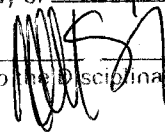
