This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Amended Order Conditionally Approving Stipulation. The Court reviewed the order, the stipulation, and the parties' consent to the terms of the Board's order, and determined by a majority that an order imposing a 36-month suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

John Cameron Bolliger is suspended from the practice of law for 36 months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Mr. Bolliger shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
