This matter came before the Supreme Court on the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Matthew O'Conner, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation of suspension. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and the Court determined unanimously that this order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

Matthew O'Conner is suspended from the practice of law for six months followed by probation for a period of 24 months beginning on the date Matthew O'Conner is reinstated to active status to practice law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Matthew O'Conner shall comply with the conditions of probation specified in the Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officers Recommendation.
