On May 21, 2018, the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon entered an Order suspending Mark Gene Obert from the practice of law in Oregon for 30 days, all stayed, pending successful completion of a one-year term of probation. Pursuant to ELC 9.2(d), the Clerk stayed this matter until the stay in Oregon expired. On May 24, 2019, the WSBA notified the Court that Mr. Obert had successfully completed the terms of probation. Therefore, on May 30, 2019, this Court entered an order lifting the stay and directing Mr. Obert to notify this Court within 60 days as to why identical discipline should not be imposed in the State of Washington. Mr. Obert has not filed a response to the order. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined by unanimously that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Mark Gene Obert is suspended from the practice of law for 30 days, all stayed based on his successful completion of a one-year term of probation in Oregon.
