This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Six-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Matthew W. Butler and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on December 2, 2016. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to Six-Month Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Matthew W. Butler is suspended from the practice of law for 6 months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Mr. Butler shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment of restitution to Clark County Indigent Defense.
