This matter came before the Supreme Court on the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Patrick Michael Pasion, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation of suspension. Patrick Michael Pasion is suspended from the practice of law for one year followed by probation for a period of 24 months beginning on the date Mr. Pasion is reinstated to active status to practice law. Pursuant to ELC 13:2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Pasion shall comply with the conditions of probation specified in the Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officers Recommendation.
