This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Suspension and Probation. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined unanimously that an order imposing a three-month suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

James Egan is suspended from the practice of law for three months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. The lawyer shall be subject to twenty-four months of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
