I. ADMISSION TO PRACTICE

At all times material to the complaint, you were licensed to practice in the state of Washington.

II. FACTS

- 1. You were hired by Ana Ortiz to represent her in two personal injury cases arising from separate automobile collisions; one involving James Hajek and a second involving Asli Mohamed. Ortiz's daughter was a passenger in the vehicle that was involved in the Hajek collision.
 - 2. You assigned the case to the junior partner in the firm, Matthew Pfefer.
