This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Eric Cameron Hoort, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation of disbarment. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's Order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and determined unanimously that the recommendation should be approved.
