This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Douglas Holmes Prestrud, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the hearing officer's recommendation that Mr. Prestrud be suspended for a period of six months. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and the Court determined unanimously that this order should be entered.
