By order of the Oregon State Bar Disciplinary Board approving a stipulation of the parties, Ross Alan Day was suspended for 30 days effective July 1, 2019, all of which was stayed pending successful completion of a one-year term of probation. Mr. Day was disciplined for violating Oregon's RPC 1.1, RPC 1.7(a), RPC 1.16(a)(1) and RPC 8.4(a)(4). The Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) notified this Court of the suspension on July 1, 2019, and the Clerk stayed this matter pursuant to ELC 9.2(d) until the stay in Oregon expired. On July 2, 2020, the WSBA advised the Court by letter that the Oregon State Bar had closed its file on the case because Mr. Day had successfully completed the terms of his probation. At that time, the stay was lifted and the Court entered an order pursuant to ELC 9.2(c) directing Mr. Day to inform this Court why it should not impose the identical discipline in this state. Mr. Day did not file a response to the order. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Ross Alan Day is suspended from the practice of law for 30 days effective July 1, 2019, with the entire suspension stayed based on successful completion of the one-year term of probation in Oregon.
