STIPULATION TO SUSPENSION

This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 90 Day Suspension and Granting Protective Order pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Nathan P. Albright, his counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on February 15, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Nathan P. Albright is suspended from the practice of law for 90 days. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Albright shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment of \$1,000 to the Washington State Bar Association for attorney fees and administrative costs in accordance with ELC 13.9(i), and auditor costs of \$1,530.
