This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 30-Month Suspension. The stipulation was signed by Souphavady Bounlutay, her counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on March 1, 2019. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing a 30-month suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Souphavady Bounlutay is suspended from the practice of law for 30 months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Ms. Bounlutay shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and she shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
