ORDER IMPOSING 3-YEAR SUSPENSION

This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Amended Order Conditionally Approving Stipulation. The Court (Justice Stephens recused) reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined unanimously that an order imposing a three-year suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Erik Eugene Highberg is suspended from the practice of law for three years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Mr. Highberg shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
