This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving a Stipulation to One-Year Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Liam Aneurin McCann and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on September 18, 2014. The Court reviewed the order and the Stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to One-Year Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Liam Aneurin McCann.
