On June 19, 2018, Donald G. Henslee resigned in lieu of discipline from the State Bar of Texas. The Texas Supreme Court accepted the resignation by order entered July 6, 2018. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Texas, this Court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.4, directing Mr. Henslee to inform this Court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in this state would be unwarranted. Mr. Henslee was served with the order on October 9, 2018. As of this date, Mr. Henslee has not filed a response. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and therefore Donald G. Henslee is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order.
