On March 30, 2019, the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona entered an Order suspending Charles James Bruen III from the practice of law in Arizona for four months. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mr. Bruen to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. Mr. Bruen signed an acknowledgment of service on April 30, 2019, but did not file a response. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

## IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Charles James Bruen III is suspended from the practice of law for four months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order.
