This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving a stipulation to a two-year suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Christopher Dobbs Schwindt and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on August 17, 2012. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the stipulation to a two-year suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Christopher Dobbs Schwindt is suspended from the practice of law for two years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Christopher Dobbs Schwindt.
