ORDER APPROVING
STIPULATION TO DISBARMENT

This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Disbarment. The stipulation was signed by Lorn Walberg and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on December 5, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing disbarment should be entered. Now, therefore, it is
ORDERED:

Lorn Walberg is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order. Lorn Walberg shall comply with the terms of the stipulation in regard to the payment of restitution and payment of costs and expenses to the WSBA.
