DISCIPLINARY BOARD ORDER ADOPTING HEARING OFFICER'S DECISION

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board ("Board") at its July 11, 2014 meeting, on review of Hearing Officer William S. Bailey's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Hearing Officer's Recommendation dated December 18, 2013 ("Decision"), recommending a twelve-month suspension and other conditions noted at page 14 of the Decision.

The Board reviews the hearing officer's finding of fact for substantial evidence. The Board reviews conclusions of law and sanction recommendations de novo. Evidence not presented to the hearing officer or panel cannot be considered by the Board. ELC 11.12(b).
