This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving a Stipulation to Two-Year Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Dawn Marie Hiller and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on December 5, 2013. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Dawn Marie Hiller.
